Monthly Police Report - March 7th - April 7th

Incidents of note over the reporting period:

Overnight 28th / 29th Mar Theft of a section of dry stone wall in the Ellerton Abbey area.

Overnight 30th / 31st Mar Theft of a trials bike and Quad from an outbuilding off Arkengarthdale Road Reeth. Between 1200 and 1845 hrs 1st Apr Burglary of residential dwelling Reeth Road Caravan Park

We do not report crimes whereby victims could be identified for example, Domestic Violence or Harassment, although they are included in the totals below.

In total in the reporting period, for the area covered by Leyburn, 133 calls were received covering a variety of incidents.

Once again the door to door sellers are visiting the area, claiming to be selling household goods as part of their probation or to gain points towards an apprenticeship scheme. Do not feel that you are helping them in anyway, politely refuse, close the door and report the incident to North Yorkshire Police, providing a description and if possible any vehicle details.
